Manpower Survey Results in June 2011

- Total employment increased by 26,000(+0.25%) in June to 10,696,000, and it also increased by 213,000(+2.03%) when compared with that of the previous year.
 - --Employment in agriculture, the goods-producing sector and the services-providing sector rose by 2,000(+0.42%), 12,000(+0.31%) and 12,000(+0.20%) respectively in June.
 - --Compared with that of the previous year, employment in the goods-producing sector and the services-providing sector increased by 129,000 (+3.42%) and 95,000 (+1.55%) respectively in June, however, employment in agriculture decreased by 11,000 (-2.08%).

- The unemployment rate was up by 0.08 percentage points in June to 4.35 percent, in contrast, the seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was slightly down by 0.01 percentage points to 4.40 percent.
 - --Compared with that of the previous year, the unemployment rate and the seasonally adjusted unemployment rate decreased by 0.81 and 0.79 percentage points in June respectively.
 - --The number of unemployed persons in June was 486,000, an increase of 10,000 (+2.12%) but a decrease of 84,000 (-14.67%) from the previous month and that of the previous year respectively.
- Labor force participation rose by 0.14 percentage points to 58.11 percent, it also rose by 0.09 percentage points from that of the previous year.

- Total employment increased by 22,000(+0.20%) in May to 10,670,000, and it also increased by 211,000(+2.01%) when compared with that of the previous year.
 - --Employment in the goods-producing sector rose by 28,000(+0.72%) in May, however, employment in agriculture and the services-providing sector decreased by 4,000(-0.87%) and 2,000(-0.03%) respectively.
 - --Compared with that of the previous year, employment in the goods-producing sector and the services-providing sector increased by 131,000 (+3.49%) and 96,000 (+1.56%) respectively in May, however, employment in agriculture decreased by 16,000 (-2.97%).

- Labor force participation rose by 0.06 percentage points to 57.97 percent, it also rose by 0.05 percentage points from that of the previous year.
