Earnings and Productivity Statistics in July 2011

In July 2011, the total nonagricultural payroll employment, at 6,888 thousand, increased by 54 thousand (or 0.79%) than last month. In comparison from July 2010 through July 2011, payroll employees increased by 212 thousand (or 3.17%). The average employment since January 2011 was 6,801 thousand, increased by 216 thousand (or 3.28%) than the same period of last year. The average monthly hours of work (including regular and over-time) for industry and service sectors in July 2011 totaled to 181.8 hours, up by 1.6 hours than last month and down by 6.7 hours than the same month of last year. The average working-hour since January 2011 was 2.3 hours less than the same period of last year. Average monthly earnings were NT\$42,663, which was 2.28%, 2.63% more than last month and the same month of last year, respectively. The average labor productivity index since January 2011 was 7.25% more than the same period of last year, while the unit output labor cost index since January 2011 was reported 2.02% decreasing.

Employees

Affected by the entrance of graduated students and summer vacation part-time workers, the total nonagricultural payroll employment in July 2011, at 6,888 thousand, increased by 54 thousand (or 0.79%) than last month. Among all industries, the service sector had shared 54.40%. In comparison from July 2010 through July 2011, payroll employees increased by 212 thousand (or 3.17%). The average employment since January 2011 was 6,801 thousand, increased by 216 thousand (or 3.28%) than the same period of last year. The industrial sector increased 4.17% and the service sector increased 2.55%. Among all industries, the employees increased mostly in manufacturing industry (115 thousand).

Turnover Rate

The average accession rate within industry and service sectors in July 2011 came to 3.08 percent, increased by 0.26 percent point than last month and decreased by 0.07 percent than the same month of last year, while the separation rate of 2.29 percent, down by 0.19 percentage point than last month and up 0.02 percentage than the same month of last year.

The average accession rate from January 2011 to July 2011 was 2.61 percent, down by 0.07 percent than the same period of last year. Between them, the industrial sector decreased by 0.20 percentage point and the service sector increased by 0.03 percentage point. The average separation rate was 2.34%, down by 0.01 percent than the same period of last year. The industrial sector increased by 0.01 percentage point, the service sector decreased 0.06 percentage point.

Earnings

Average monthly earnings (including regular and irregular earnings) per employee at the industrial and service sector in July 2011 were NT\$42,663. Comparing with last month and a year ago, there was 2.28% and 2.63% increasing respectively. The average regular earnings in July were NT\$36,760, 0.28% increasing from last month and 1.53% increasing than the same month of last year.

The average regular earnings since January 2011 were NT\$36,614, increased by 1.33% than the same period of last year. The average irregular earnings were NT\$11,423, which increased 9.68% from the same period of last year. Together with regular and irregular earnings, the average monthly earnings since January 2011 was NT\$48,037, which was 3.20% more than the same period of last year and reached the highest level in history, of the same period of past years. After deflating by the Consumer Price Index increasing rate (1.44%), the real average earnings up 1.74% and the real regular earnings down by 0.11%.

Hours of work

The average monthly hours of work for industry and service sectors in July 2011 totaled to 181.8 hours, up by 1.6 hours than last month and down by 6.7 hours than the same month of last year. The average working-hour since January 2011 was 175.8 hours, decreased by 2.3 hours than the same period of last year.

The industry with the most decreasing working-hour than the same period of last year was education industry that reported 5.6 hours decreasing, followed by transportation and storage industry which showed 5.0 hours.

Labor Productivity and Unit Output Labor Cost

In July 2011, the manufacturing sector's labor productivity index was 129.54 (2006=100), increased by 0.54% than last month and up by 4.44% than the same month of last year. The manufacturing unit output labor cost index were 75.58 (2006=100), increased by 4.44% than last month and up by 3.63% than the same month of last year.

The average labor productivity index since January 2011 was 7.25% more than the same period of last year, while the unit output labor cost index since January 2011 was reported 2.02% decreasing.
