

Manpower Survey Results in June 2017

- Total employment increased by 6,000(+0.05%) in June to 11,337,000, moreover, it increased by 86,000(+0.76%) when compared with that of the previous year.

--Employment in agriculture slightly decreased by 1,000(-0.22%) in June ; however, the goods-producing sector and the services-providing sector increased by 4,000(+0.08%) and 4,000(+0.06%) respectively.

--Compared with that of the previous year, employment in agriculture decreased by 3,000(-0.53%), the goods-producing sector and the services-providing sector increased by 23,000(+0.56%) and 66,000(+0.99%) in June, respectively.

- The unemployment rate increased by 0.08 percentage points to 3.74 percent in June, but the seasonally adjusted unemployment rate decreased by 0.01 percentage points to 3.78 percent.

--Compared with that of the previous year, the unemployment rate and the seasonally adjusted unemployment rate both fell by 0.18 percentage points in June.

--The number of unemployed persons was 440,000 in June, it increased by 9,000(2.09%) but decreased by 19,000(-4.18%) from the previous month and that of the previous year, respectively.

- Labor force participation rate was 58.75 percent in June, which increased by 0.05 and 0.07 percentage points from the previous month and that of the previous year, respectively.
