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TAIWAN'S ECONOMIC PERFORMANCE IN THE SECOND QUARTER OF 2010 AND OUTLOOK FOR 2010-2011

Economic Performance in the Second Quarter of 2010 and Forecasts for 2010

The external sector extends brilliant performance with the real exports of goods and services advanced by 34.27% in the second quarter of 2010. Associating with 9.24% growth of the domestic sector, the preliminary estimation of real gross domestic products (GDP) increased by 12.53% from the same quarter of the previous year. Meanwhile, the GDP growth rate of the first quarter is upwardly revised to 13.71% (formerly 13.27%). The seasonally adjusted annual rate (saar) of the real GDP is 7.23% in the second quarter, the first quarter is revised to 10.86% (formerly 11.28%).

Looking forward the second half of 2010, the propelling strength of external sector will turn to be modest. Accompanying with domestic sector recovery, real GDP is forecasted to grow 8.24% in 2010. CPI is predicted to rise by 1.23%.

Outlook for 2011

The latest world economic forecast indicates the growth of the world economy in 2011 will moderate. Accordingly, Taiwan's export is anticipated to keep growing mildly. Combining the contribution from domestic sector, real GDP will grow by 4.64% in 2011. CPI will gently rise 1.43%.
