

## Manpower Survey Results in March 2018

- Total employment increased by 6,000(+0.05%) in March to 11,403,000; moreover, it increased by 90,000(+0.79%) when compared with that of the previous year.

--Employment in agriculture and the services-providing sector increased by 1,000(+0.15%) and 5,000(+0.07%) in March, respectively ; the goods-producing sector remained the same.

--Compared with that of the previous year, employment in agriculture, the goods-producing sector and the services-providing sector increased by 3,000(+0.56%), 24,000(+0.58%) and 63,000 (+0.94%) in March, respectively.

- The unemployment rate fell by 0.04 percentage points to 3.66 percent in March, moreover, the seasonally adjusted unemployment rate also dropped by 0.03 percentage points to 3.67 percent.

--Compared with that of the previous year, the unemployment rate fell by 0.12 percentage points in March.

--The number of unemployed persons was 433,000 in March, it decreased by 5,000(-1.18%) from the previous month , moreover, it decreased by 12,000(-2.74%) from that of the previous year.

- Labor force participation rate was 58.87 percent in March, which dropped by 0.01 percentage points from the previous month; in contrast, it rose by 0.14 percentage points from that of the previous year.
